### Aktivitäten

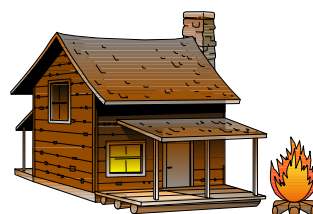
