There are 15 points for this task, a maximum of 5 points for each section: Content \& Elaboration - Structures \& Vocabulary - Discourse. Pupils are not expected to produce faultless English; to achieve 15 points, a pupil should write a generically appropriate coherent and cohesive text that successfully communicates all parts of the message (content point 1 - content point 2 - content point 3 ) using a level-appropriate range of structures and vocabulary, and that contains only a few minor errors.
